Summer School 2017 - Information for students

Course dates

This year's course runs between July 17th and 21st. We start at 10am on the Monday morning but you are welcome to arrive on the Sunday evening. The course finishes with a concert on the Friday evening to which family and friends are welcome. If you prefer, you can stay after the concert and leave on the Saturday morning.

Venue

The summer school is held at Ruskin Mill, near Nailsworth in Gloucestershire. Full directions will be sent if we offer you a place.

Applications

The course is open to musicians from all backgrounds and of varied levels of ability and experience. The number of places we offer is limited by the space available and it is vital that we can put together a group which is balanced in terms of approximate ability levels, interests and instrumentation. Consequently we ask you to complete and return the following application form.

Fee

Tuition costs £230, including free (basic) camping on site. Students are welcome to arrange their own b&b accommodation if they prefer; and we can usually put people in touch with local hosts who offer hospitality in their homes for a very reasonable charge.

We ask you to send a £60 deposit with your application form. If we offer you a place, this deposit becomes non-refundable, but if we aren't able to offer you a place this year, it will be returned to you. The balance of the course fee is due two weeks before the course starts, and in the event of non-payment your place may be offered to another student if we are oversubscribed.

Food

We shop, cook and eat together throughout the week, and everyone contributes to a slush fund for ingredients. The cost is very reasonable, usually around £30-40 per person.
